## SUMMER CARE & CAMP INFORMATION

**Registration** for **Summer Camp and Enrichment Camps** is open to all age/grade eligible students, on a first-come, first-served basis. **Please pull out Pages 26-33 in the center of the booklet, open pages and staple at the top left corner, then fill out a separate form for each student.** *Daily or weekly drop-ins will be accepted based on space availability for field trips.* St. Anthony reserves the right to refuse or remove any student who does not follow camp rules or whose tuition is not current.

**Summer Camp Registration (Blue & Gold Camp, Camp Sunrise, Camp Sunset) Fee and Enrichment Camp/s Tuition** are due at the time of registration. Summer Camp tuition is due by 8am on the Monday of each week registered.

**Morning Drop-off** From 7:30a.m. in the cafeteria. Sign in required. **Mid-Day Drop-off** 12:15—12:30p.m. in the cafeteria. Sign in required.

**Pick-up** for all students is through the cafeteria. Camp Sunrise students must be signed out by parent or guardian by 12:30 p.m., and all others by 6:00p.m.

**Discipline** Parents of students displaying unacceptable behavior will be notified immediately. This may result in immediate removal from the program or field trip. There will be no refunds.

**Cancelled Enrichment Camps and Refunds** Registration may be cancelled and the tuition refunded two weeks prior to beginning of the class minus a \$50 cancellation fee for each week that classes are cancelled. If a class is cancelled by St. Anthony's due to conditions beyond our control (e.g., weather, fire, etc.), no refunds will be given and the tuition is not transferable to another class. We reserve the right to cancel classes due to insufficient enrollment, the tuition may be transferred to another class or refunded in full. Parents will be notified of such cancellations the week prior to the class.
