

K-4 Checklist

Reading Readiness

1. Demonstrates knowledge of basic vocabulary.
2. Communicates well orally (uses language to express themselves)
3. Is developing listening skills.
4. Recognizes capital and lower case letters.
5. Becomes aware of various speech sounds and patterns.
6. Understands positional terms (under, over, in, out)
7. Begin to recognize their first and last name.
8. Be able to respond to “why”, “how”, “when” question about conversations heard and stories read aloud.

Mathematics

1. Identifies basic shapes and colors.
2. Identifies numerals 0-20.
3. Match objects in a one-to-one correspondence.
4. Demonstrates sequencing skills.
5. Demonstrates understanding of number concepts.
6. Demonstrates ability to compare and contrast.
7. Demonstrates sorting skills.
8. Demonstrates understanding of math terms (addition, subtraction and equal)

Physical Development

1. Is developing gross motor coordination, jumping, running, etc.
2. Is developing fine motor coordination grip on a pencil and scissors, drawing shapes and letters, etc.

Social/Emotional Development

1. Is developing a positive self-image.
2. Behaves during instruction and story time.
3. Follows directions.
4. Accepts responsibility for their actions and jobs.
5. Adjusts to new situations.
6. Demonstrates self-control.
7. Is considerate of others.
8. Displays self-help skills.
9. Completes tasks during a given time.

Participates and cooperates in a learning activity during circle time, outside time and center time.

Religion

1. Become aware of God’s love and gifts to us.
2. Participates in prayer experiences.
3. Participates in group discussions.
4. Knows the Sign of the Cross.
5. Becomes aware of the Holy Bible and the awareness of Prayer Service.
